(a) Valid PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (Platinum Membership) (all pages) in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of the IRR:

- (b) Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid (UPOU BAC Form No. 1); and
- (c) Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid, except under conditions provided under the rules. The SLCC should be at least 50% of the ABC. (UPOU BAC Form No. 2); "The prospective bidder must have completed an SLCC that is similar to the contract to be bid, and whose value, adjusted to current prices using the PSA consumer price indices, must be at least fifty (50%) of the ABC to be bid: *Provided however*, That contractors under Small A and Small B categories without similar experience on the contract to be bid may be allowed to bid if the cost of such contract is not more than the Allowable Range of Contract Cost (ARCC) of their registration based on the guidelines as prescribed by the PCAB."and

- (e) Original copy of Bid Security. If in the form of a Surety Bond, submit also a certification issued by the Insurance Commission; or

- (f) Project Requirements, which shall include the following:
 - a. Organizational chart for the contract to be bid;
 - b. Key personnel Letter Certificate to UPOU to be assigned to the contract to be bid, with their complete qualification (Bio-Data) and experience data (COE):

<u>and</u> if applicable, Original Notarized Secretary's Certificate (UPOU BAC Form No. 5) in case of a corporation, partnership, or cooperative; or Original Special Power of Attorney (UPOU BAC Form No. 6) of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder.
